## Our Condolences

St Brigid's School extends its deepest sympathy to K'Lorena, Khan and Odin on the sad loss of their father and partner - Shane. Although many of our families may not have known Shane well, the support received from our community has been heart-warming.

Today I spoke with K'Lorena who is still in hospital with Khan. He is stable and they are working on keeping his body still due to some vertebrae damage. He is being looked after by medical staff as he remains in the Intensive Care unit. K'Lorena was very appreciative of the support shown to her by this community. There will be a long road ahead for Khan. K'Lorena mentioned that at this stage, Khan will be required to wear a cast over his torso for a period of time to ensure his body remains fixed and to aid healing.

The Parents and Friends (P&F) are organising support following this Friday's Disco. The money raised from this event will be used to help K'Lorena.

## How can you help?

One of the biggest ways to support families in need that our school community has, is access to the 'Food bank'. The food bank is simply a freezer/fridge located in the Parish, with food in it to be given to families facing crisis or hardship. At the moment, the food in this fridge is very low. If families wish to help, please get in touch with Fran Wilson (0427 707 873) who will give you some meat to cook up and turn into something made with love. It may be a lasagna, pasta bake or something of your choice. Once the meal is frozen, we can ensure that K'Lorena and her boys are looked after on their return home to Bridgetown.
