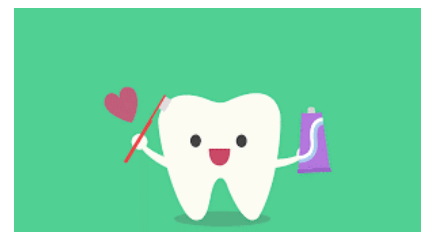
DENTAL VAN
