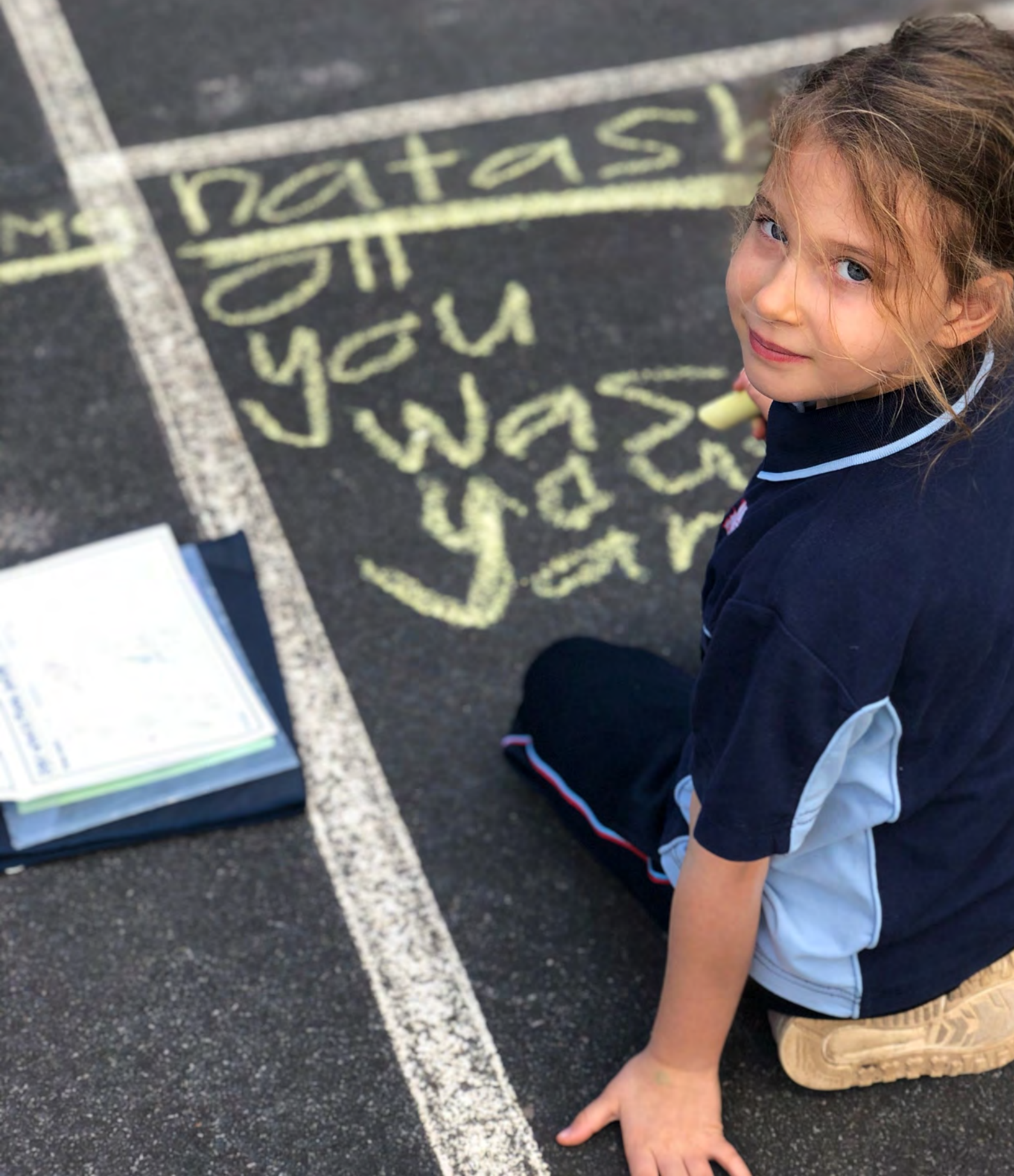

## CDF Pay

CDF Pay is aimed at making the process of ordering lunches and uniforms easier for you without having to find loose change and filling in lunch bags on the way out the door! Orders on canteen days (Tuesday and Friday) must be submitted by 8.45am. But please, don't stress if you miss the cut-off time, we will still be on the end of the phone - you can always ring through your order. Uniform items are received by the front office in the morning, even if you placed an order the night before. If you urgently need an item of clothing, please simply call us and we can assist you.
