JDRF Diabetes Awareness

You might not know but our school has three students with Type 1 Diabetes. This is because they look like every other person but they have an important difference - they cannot produce their own insulin. You cannot catch Type 1 Diabetes and it's not caused by lack of exercise or too much sugar.

Next week, our school will recognise the importance insulin plays in the lives of these students. There is no known way to prevent Type 1 Diabetes, but scientists are working on it through the support of the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (JDRF).

This coming Thursday 10 June, we are asking all children to come to school in their uniform whilst also wearing some blue accessories. This may be wearing a beanie, scarf, hair ribbons, socks or cap just to mention a few. Together with a gold coin donation, our school will support the JDRF and the great work it does to assist our three students.

'Kiss and Drop' bay coming!

The Shire will be installing some 'Kiss and Drop' bays in the coming months at the front of the school library. The bays will be sign posted as a designated 'Kiss and

Drop' area during the school zone hours: 7.30am - 9.00am and 2.30pm - 4.00pm. The idea behind this rezoning will be to move cars in and out of this area quickly to allow for a smoother entry and exit. Please keep an eye out for the new signage which will indicate when this will take effect.
