We do this to raise awareness of Autism and raise funds - 50% of the funds are given directly back to our school to help us purchase resources that assist our children with Autism. ### COVID update

This week all families received an email containing a link to support our planning for your child's classroom attendance. We ask that you notify St Brigid's School if your child returns a negative PCR/ RAT result, after:

- being identified as a close contact (Day 1 test to return to school as an asymptomatic close contact), and/or
- being identified as a household close contact (Day 7 test to conclude quarantine).

To help streamline the process a COVID-19 Self-reporting 'Form' (accessible via the link emailed to parents) for Students and Staff members has been developed by Catholic Education WA (CEWA). Parents and caregivers can now inform the school of their child's positive or negative COVID result.

### Parent-Teacher phone meetings

A link was sent to all families this week via email to an on-line booking system for parent interviews which are coming up. If you have not had the opportunity to book a time to speak with your child's teacher, please do so. The majority of parent meetings are scheduled to take place on Wednesday 6 April. On this day, school closes early (12.00pm) so the teachers can begin phoning parents. Due to COVID restrictions, unfortunately parents will not be able to attend meetings on-site. All meetings will take place over the phone.
